We have just received the results of another Blue/Green Algae test. These are from water samples taken earlier this week.

Although the levels of blue-green algae concentration have reduced (particularly in the middle of the lake where it has roughly halved) they are still far above the WHO's no swimming threshold.

The warning signs will remain out for you to read.
