Piddinghoe re-build - The Solar Panels

We've just been awarded £7500 from Sport England to install Solar Panels at Piddinghoe.

Our thanks goes to Ben Metz and Ian Lambert securing the award.

The purpose of the solar panels is to run the aerator pumps as one of techniques we have in place to mitigate the increase of blue green algae resulting from climate change.

A condition of the grant is that the panels must be installed within the next 6 months.

Another grant for the sum of £75,000 has just been applied for from Viola. To help fund the next stage of the Piddinghoe re-build, we're calling this stage 2a – The Changing Facilities.

Thanks again to Ben and Ian for the massive amount of form filling. We all have our fingers crossed for a good outcome.
