Please see below updates on important points related to marking of launching trollies, guidance for wing, board and kite surfers, together with updates on relocation of menu items on the NSSC website as follows:

Marking of launching trollies and trailers, From Noel West, Sailing Section

To help our berth masters and also to enhance safety, particularly at Seaford, we require all members to attach a waterproof tag to their boat trolley. We will provide the tag and a means of attaching it to your trolley.

Please see Noel West for your waterproof tag.

You should mark each tag with a waterproof marker, which we will provide, with the following information:

- 1. Name of sailor
- 2. Model of boat
- 3. Boat/Sail number

This will start from the new year at Piddinghoe and from our first Sunday sailing session at Seaford. The Club bylaws will be updated to reflect this mandatory requirement which is a condition of your berthing a boat or storing a trolley or trailer on our sites.

Guidance for Board/Foil/Wing & Kite Surfers

Carolyn Turner has, with approval from Justin Attwood and the board, produced an important set of guidelines intended to support members who board, foil wing or kite surf from NSSC locations, with primary focus on sea based activity at Seaford. These are based on input from our members and RYA best practice. We will review and update these from time to time with contribution from our growing membership who enjoy these exciting watersports.
